




LONGITUDINAL DATA SYSTEM

Take a virtual class data dive! You have the ability to see your class (Elementary) or classes by period (Secondary) with individual student risk factors for attendance, discipline, report card marks, Smarter Balanced, and Universal Screeners.

MULTIPLE MEASURES STUDENT SCREENING REPORT

Log onto *lds.k12.hi.us*. Username is your 8-digit employee ID number. Password is what you use for the DOE Intranet, PDE 3, or eCSSS.

Click on the Reports Tab > Currently Enrolled Students > MMSS Profile Report



Find your name in the **Staff** pull-down menu; Select your desired period in the **Course** pull-down menu; Click the **View Report** button.

Look for strengths and areas of need for your students based on how they ended last school year.
