
The purpose of this guide is to provide instructions on how to modify student discipline records that are impacted by the Hawaii State Department of Education's decision to adjust out-of-school suspension days.

For assistance in identifying students with out-of-school suspension records affected, run the following Ad Hoc Report:

Path: Ad Hoc Reporting > Data Export > \$Behavior Write folder OR *Elementary Principal/VP folder OR *Secondary Principal/VP folder > student Chapter 19 School Closure Report.


Search for student



- 2. Go to the student's **Behavior** tab.
- 3. Click on Incident that contains the disciplinary resolution to be modified (link in blue)



4. Click on Incident ID on Incident Details window that will appear on the right side of the screen.



- 5. You will be directed to behavior management with the selected incident highlighted.
- 6. If the incident is locked, click unlock




7. Click on the resolution that needs to be modified.



- 8. Resolution Details:
 - ** Steps for modifying a resolution when **Suspension** days were served prior to 3/13/2020
 - Change Resolution End Date to 3/13/20
 - Remove Attendance code if previously selected
 - Note change in "Duration in School Days"



- ** Steps for modifying a resolution when **no days were served**.
 - Change Resolution to Other
 - Change "Duration in School Days" to zero
 - Change Resolution End Date to the same date as Resolution Start Date




9. Document in the details field.



11. Change Incident Status to complete and Click save to lock record.




12. Click on Student Name on the left side panel

15. Select the "Copy" form on Custom Forms Screen. You will make changes to this "copy" version.
