Registration will end when we are at capacity or one week prior to the workshop to allow leaders to prepare supplies for each participant. Registration will be confirmed by email.
3. Upon confirmation of registration, please complete the WH-1 form at [go.hawaii.edu/3aM](https://go.hawaii.edu/3aM) (print the two pages) with an original signature and upload a digital (scanned) copy to [go.hawaii.edu/px3](https://go.hawaii.edu/px3) (this is an encrypted and secure folder that is managed by Eōmailani Kukahiko, we cannot accept DocuScan and the like). *(If you feel you have already completed this step please email us at [opualii@hawaii.edu](mailto:opualii@hawaii.edu) to check if your information is already in our financial system.)*
4. Each applicant will be required to fill out a post-workshop survey, detailing the benefit of the workshop attended (for them personally, their classroom, school and community) at [go.hawaii.edu/3kX](https://go.hawaii.edu/3kX).
