

LONGITUDINAL DATA SYSTEM

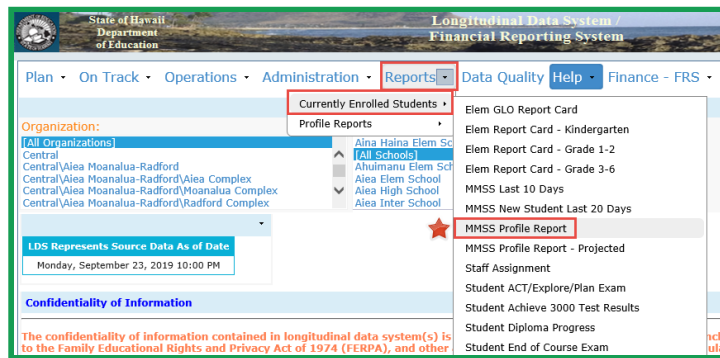

Log onto lds.k12.hi.us. Username is your 8-digit employee ID number. Password is what you use for the DOE Intranet, PDE 3, or eCSSS.

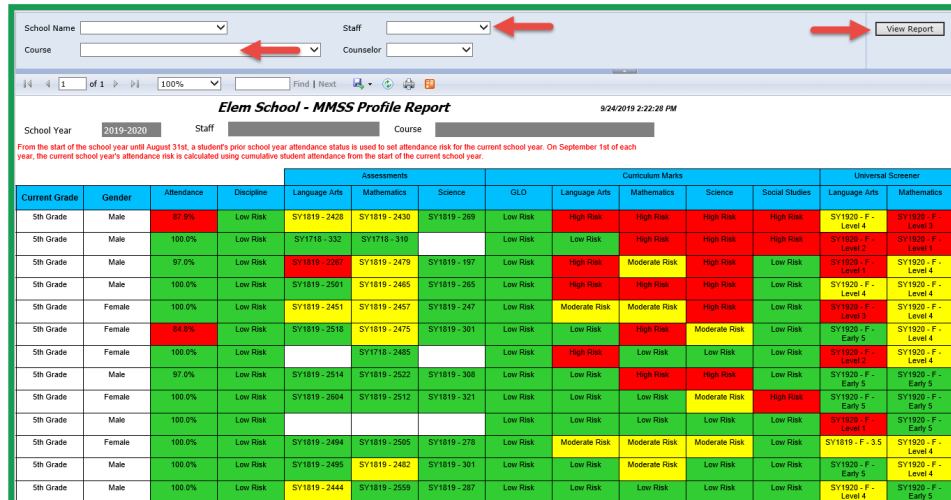

Find your name in the **Staff** pull-down menu; Select your desired period in the **Course** pull-down menu; Click the **View Report** button.

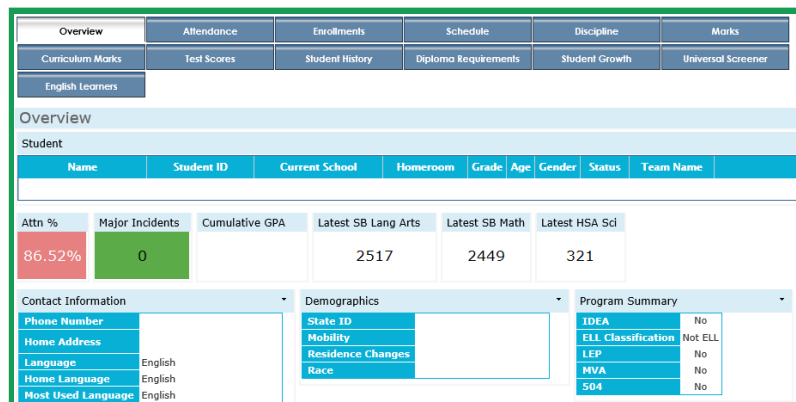

See longitudinal data for a student by clicking on the **student's ID number** next to their name.

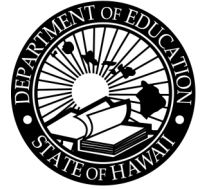
