SUBJECT: Updated COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement Guidelines for New Employees

This updates the COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement Guidelines for New Employees memorandum dated March 31, 2022. Effective immediately, the Hawaii State Department of Education (Department) will no longer require newly hired employees to be vaccinated for COVID-19 unless assigned to work in a congregate setting. The positions designated as working in a congregate setting are House Parents at the Hawaii School for the Deaf and Blind and School Dormitory Attendants for the Lahainaluna High School boarding program.

Only newly hired employees assigned to work in a congregate setting will need to provide documentation that they are fully vaccinated or have an approved medical or religious exemption from the Department prior to establishing a start date.

All employees are encouraged to get a COVID-19 vaccination and are permitted to take up to two (2) hours of release time to get the shot during work hours when authorized.
