Ren's Story:

Ren Miyasaki is a sophomore at Pearl City High School who was born with a heart condition (Hypoplastic left heart syndrome). He underwent surgery shortly after birth and continued to have to be monitored throughout his life. This year, he began to experience fainting spells and complications resulting in the need for a heart transplant. In October, he received a heart and underwent eight hours of surgery at the Children's Hospital in Los Angeles. He must remain in Los Angeles for at least a year to continue to monitor and strengthen his new heart.
