# EUTF Open Enrollment for Active Employees



Open enrollment (OE) is the time for you to review whether the health coverage you have for yourself and your family continues to best meet your needs. **The OE election period is April 1 - 30, 2024.** 

#### During the OE election period, you can:

- Add, change or drop a plan
- Add or remove dependents
- Change coverage tiers, such as changing from Self to Family, or Family to Two-Party

If you decide to keep your current plans, you don't need to take action. You are not required to complete any forms to continue your current coverage.

If you are making changes, submit changes through the EUTF Member self-service portal at <u>eutfbenefits.hawaii.gov</u> or complete and submit the EC-1 enrollment form available on the website at eutf.hawaii.gov (or EC-1H for those enrolled in HSTA VB plans).

OE change requests and required supporting documents must be submitted through the EUTF Member self-service portal at eutfbenefits.hawaii.gov by April 30, 2024. If you don't enroll through the EUTF Member self-service portal, submit your completed EC-1/EC-1H enrollment form and required supporting documents to your employer's open enrollment designee by April 30, 2024, for changes to be effective July 1, 2024. Please do not submit changes through both the Member self-service portal AND open enrollment designee (i.e. hard copy EC-1/EC-1H form).

Required supporting documents must be submitted by April 30, 2024. The EUTF will not contact you regarding outstanding supporting documents, and late submissions will not be accepted.

## **Important!**

Your Confirmation Notice can be viewed by logging into the EUTF Member Self-Service portal at <u>eutfbenefits.hawaii.gov</u>. Confirmation Notices reflecting Open Enrollment changes will be available in the months of May-June. If your Confirmation Notice is not available in the EUTF Member Self-Service portal by the end of June or if you would like a printed copy to be mailed to you, please contact the EUTF at 1-808-586-7390 or toll-free at 1-800-295-0089.
